Cfine Foodbank Collection

For a week from Wednesday 5 October young people in S6 visited all registration classes to collect and encourage donations of items and cash for our foodbank collection for CFine https://www.cfine.org/,

They worked very hard each morning and were not discouraged: I was proud of their perseverance. Thank you for all of the contributions that you made. As well as all the food donations we received which were enough to fill ten crates we also received a total of £223.72 in cash donations. Miss Strachan and I took a small group of young people shopping on Thursday morning with this cash and purchased enough items to fill a further seven crates. This is a truly outstanding contribution from our pupils and their families. Last session a normal collection was somewhere

in the region of eight crates per term and this term we have more than doubled our donation! Thank You for your support!

The young people pictured above showed that by working together as part of a team and not giving up that great things can be achieved. Individually some were disappointed that on some days there were small numbers or no donations. However, they can now see the excellent result of their collective efforts. I am very proud of all our pupils who contributed to this collection.

Parents' Evenings and Report Schedule

The results of the consultation with staff and parents/carers about whether the meetings should be face to face or online were close with a slight majority for face to face. There was a stronger preference face to face meetings from parents/carers of S1 – S3 young people than S4- S6. It is not possible to have both online and face to face on the same night. The consultation with staff was also very close.


Therefore, taking all this into account for this session we will hold S4 - S6 parents' evenings online and S1 - S3 face to face. We will review this at the end of the session.

Can I please reassure all parents/carers that if, following a parents' evening in person or online, you have further question or have queries that would take longer than 5 minutes discussion that you contact us. Your first port of call, as always, is your child's head of house. You can then discuss your concerns and if necessary arrange a further meeting.

Drinking Water

As you know we ask that families provide their child(ren) with a clear water bottle which they can fill during the school day. This reduces the amount of plastic waste and supports young people's learning: we all need to be well hydrated to do our best.

Over the course of this term a number of water bottles have been "lost" and are in the school office awaiting collection. If they belong to your child/ren please ask them to collect at the school office.
