# Head Teacher's Update - Friday 26 February 2021

#### **Parent Council**

The Parent Council continues to meet virtually during this period of school closure. They are the voice of the wider parent/carer body and give feedback on policies from their perspective and so support decision making. They are a very good sounding board and support for me as we navigate these challenging times as a school community and I thank them for their support. All meetings are on the last Tuesday of the month and the next is on Tuesday 23 March 2021 at 19.30.

We all recognise that parents and carers are not teachers and that these times are very challenging for all of you who are balancing supporting your children and your own work and family commitments. The recent survey undertaken by Aberdeen City Council has just come in and the overwhelming message is that our children all need to be back in school. There were a number of different constructive suggestions about distance learning which echoed those of the Parent Council. Thank you to all of you who recognised the hard work of the staff in supporting your children whilst balancing their own commitments with their school work.

Join Dr Caitlin Napier and Dr Louise Foubister, Senior Registrars in Child and Adolescent Mental Health, for an informal discussion about the practical strategies that might be able to help your child.

Wednesday 24 March 7.30-8.30pm An Introduction to Drugs Awareness Join Kira Weir, Training and Communications Officer for CREW to increase your knowledge and understanding of drugs, emerging drug trends and effective strategies to support your child.

## **Senior Phase Return**

This has gone well. This week young people have enjoyed being back in class and welcomed the opportunity to get on with their practical work for their certificate courses. They have complied very well with the additional measures we have in place to support their health and safety and that of their teachers. Teachers have enjoyed doing what they do best – teaching young people in school. Young people can still sign up for Covid-19 Self Testing if they are going to be in school for practical lessons – see last week's HT Update letter to families for more details.

#### **Extension of Senior Phase Return**

The First Minister announced on Tuesday of this week that all P4 – P7 pupils will return to school from 15 March 2021. She also stated that more Senior Phase (S4 – S6) pupils will also return but no detail of who or how many. We are now waiting for further information which we expect in an announcement on Tuesday 2 March 2021. As usual I will update you as soon as possible thereafter.

## **Developing the Young Workforce (DYW)**

This is a strategy developed by the Scottish Government and supported by industry to enhance young people's progress from early years, through the senior phase and beyond. It provides opportunities, for our young people, to develop the important skills for learning, skills for life and skills for work.

It also supports us to work in partnership with organisations such as Skills Development Scotland, employer groups, colleges, universities, and community learning and development (CLD). We have now also been allocated a DYW

Coordinator, Mark Dalgarno, from DYW North-East. Further information on his role will be issued in the future.

One part of our DYW work is providing our young people with information on opportunities available to them such as work placements, webinars, apprenticeships, open days and many more. All these opportunities are being advertised in the year group Google Classrooms and if they have any further questions or require support to find out more about these, young people should contact their Guidance teacher or Year Head.
