# Head Teacher's Update -Friday 26 March 2021

I write to update you as follows:

# Arrangements in place for Monday 12 April (after Easter Holidays)

Following the First Minister's announcement on Tuesday 16 March and subject to a final check on 6 April in the Easter holidays we expect to be welcoming pupils back to school on Monday 12 April with **no requirement for 2 metres physical distancing between pupils**. However, there will still be a requirement for young people to maintain 2 metres physical distance from their teachers. In addition, there is a requirement that all staff and pupils wear face coverings in the school building unless they are exempt. The mitigations that will be in place are the same as those in place prior to the Christmas holidays. For ease they are detailed below:

- Pupils will use their year group entrances.
- Pupils will report straight to their period 1 class.
- Pupils will be required to sanitise their hands when entering the building and when entering and leaving each class.
- Pupils will be required to use paper towels to clean their own workspace as directed by their teacher who will have sprayed it with Covid Guard.
- Staggered breaks and lunch will be in place for S1 to S3 and S4 to S6
- When moving through the school pupils must use the one-way system in place on the stairs and keep left in corridors.
- When leaving the building pupils must use the nearest exit to their classroom, as directed by their teacher to prevent congestion on the central staircase.
- In the school canteen pupils can remove their face covering whilst eating but must replace it thereafter.
- Pupils will be encouraged to go outside when they have finished eating.

- Unless exempt all staff and pupils must wear face coverings at all times when in the school building.
- In addition, pupils must avoid unnecessary physical contact with one another or sharing of food/drink or other personal items such as mobile phones.

All of these points were made in a presentation to pupils in school and which has been posted on each year group Google Classroom. In addition teachers have been reminded about the importance of good ventilation in classrooms as per Aberdeen City Council advice.

### **Additional Closure Days**

In order to support staff in assessing and submitting grades for young people undertaking National Qualifications the Scottish Government have agreed to two additional closure days for all school in Scotland. This is in addition to any planned in-service days. Therefore, school will be closed to pupils on the following dates:

In-service Day: Tuesday 4 May 2021 Additional Closure Day: Friday 28 May 2021 Additional Closure Day: Friday 4 June 2021

#### Assessment for S4 – S6

We are currently preparing an assessment calendar that will be shared with pupils early next term. A number of resources to support revision have been shared with young people during in school sessions and posted on Google Classroom. I draw your attention to the following:

e-Sgoil is offering an Easter programme of real-time, interactive webinars covering Nat 4 to Advanced Higher, for Scottish learners in the Senior Phase. The programme is not designed to deliver whole course content but will focus on key aspects of the subject(s) and hints and tips on how to be successful in assessments.

From 6 April to 16 April there will be three Live Webinars per course. They will be delivering over 60 courses offering 3 webinars each, over 2 weeks. All the pupils who are already registered for e-Sgoil Study Support in the evenings will be included in the Team but will have to register for e-Sgoil Easter Study Programme. Webinars will use a 'flipped learning' approach. This means that young people will have had access to high quality, online resources prior to attending each webinar.

#### Uniform

From 12 April 2021 we will revert to the same arrangements for school uniform as were in place before the Christmas Holidays. Uniform is an expectation except on days when young people have PE when they should come to school in their PE kit.

# Lateral Flow Testing S1 – S6

Details will come out shortly about pickup up arrangements for further test kits for use after the holidays. Please note that if parents/carers are picking up kits that they

will not need to enter school building. A booking system is planned, and collections will take place outside of the school building. All collections must be by prior arrangement. Any issues please contact our Covid Co-ordinator Mrs Heather Whiteford by telephone or the school email address.

# **Procedure for Return of Chromebooks**

All S1 – S3 pupils who were loaned a Chromebooks during lockdown **must** return the device to school week commencing Monday 12 of April.

Please hand the Chromebooks into the main school office.

All senior pupils who have been issued with a Chromebooks **must** bring their device into school, fully charged every day. Exceptions would only apply where it is known the device is not required on a particular day.

Senior pupils who haven't been issued with their device yet can collect it from T6. Appropriate consent form to be completed in advance.

# **Costa Rica Online Quiz Fundraising Event**

A team of young people in S4 and S5 are fundraising to embark on an expedition to Costa Rica in summer 2022. On expedition the team will be participating in activities including volunteering at a turtle conservation project, helping improve a local women's community infrastructure, and trekking through Rincon de la Vieja National Park.

The pupils are organising an online quiz which will take place on Friday the 23rd April at 7pm via the online platform Google Meet. You will need to have a Google account in order to access this platform. The entry fee will be £5 per team with a maximum of 6 per team. The winning team will receive a £30 Amazon voucher. #### How to register:

- Email your team name and names of your team members to: <u>gw16mustardmarisa1@ab-ed.org</u>. Only one team member to register on behalf of the team.
- 2. You will be invited to the online quiz and you will receive a confirmation email acknowledging your team's registration along with an invitation to join the Google Meet.
- 3. Pay your entry fee to:

  - c) The school via post:

#### Joining the Google Meet:

- 1. You will need to have a Google account set up prior to the event. If you register using a non-Google email address the invitation will be sent to this email address. When you click on the link it will ask you to join through your Google account.
- 2. You can join the Google Meet by:

#### Google Meet expectations:
