S1 Parents' Evening – Wednesday 1 December 2021

Our S1 Parents' Evening takes place on Wednesday 1 December 2021 from 4.45pm until 7.30pm and for those of you who haven't been part of a Parents' Evening at Bridge of Don Academy you may find it different from those held in your child's previous school.

Covid mitigations have led to Aberdeen City schools adopting an online system where parents can discuss their child's progress by video call.

Information was issued to S1 Parents via Groupcall on Wednesday this week, 24 November, providing details on how to access the system, make appointments and use the system on the evening itself. If you didn't receive these, please contact the school office on Monday to ensure you are able to make bookings ahead of the system closing at late Tuesday evening.

Note that your child's Guidance Teacher does not appear in the list of teachers for appointments but are happy to be contacted in school to discuss your child without the restriction of a five-minute slot.

Please bear in mind, as detailed in the information, that Apple have introduced a bug into their latest operating system, iOS 15.1, which prevents iPads and iPhones from using video on a number of web pages, including the one used for the Parents' Evening Booking System. This will be fixed by Apple in a future update, but Windows and Android devices will continue to work as expected, along with any Apple devices using an older version of the operating system.

UCAS (University and College Applications Service)

S5 and S6 pupils who are applying through UCAS for 2022 entry to university are currently completing their applications with the support and guidance of their Head of House. The school deadline for applications to be completed is **Thursday 9 December 2021**. This allows time for applications to be checked, processed, and sent before the end of term.

Please note that young people applying to NESCol (North East Scotland College) will apply directly through NESCol's online college system. They will also be supported through this process by their Head of House in the New Year.

School Photographs

All S1-S6 individual and family photographs were taken in school today, Friday 26 November. All pupils who had their photograph taken will have a proof home with them. All orders for school photographs will be online this year. The school will receive a 25% commission for all orders placed online.

The four steps in the ordering process are:

- Visit <u>www.tempest-orders.co.uk</u>
- Enter the reference number. This can be found under the proof picture
- View your photos, make your selection and check out your order
- Choose delivery option

Delivery to school is free if order is placed within 14 days. Any order placed after that will incur a postage & packaging fee which you will be required to pay.

SQA Research – Your Views are Being Sought

The SQA is currently carrying out research into people's perceptions of educational assessment standards in light of the disruption due to COVID-19. It is important for them to develop a deeper understanding of the views of a range of individuals, including learners, parents, employers, and practitioners. They anticipate that the key findings of this research will be published in the early part of 2022. A team of researchers from the Universities of Oxford and Glasgow have been asked by the SQA to carry out a large-scale survey of learners, practitioners, employers, and parents, and they are very keen to get as many responses as possible.

Forgotten Kit, Equipment or Other Items

Sometimes young people forget items such as those above – including their lunch money or packed lunch. Whilst we can take such items for them parents/carers are still not permitted in the school building unless there are exceptional circumstances. Therefore, we ask that you:

• Consider whether or not it is essential – sometimes young people need to learn the importance of organising themselves and experiencing the consequence of forgetting homework or kit can be a valuable lesson. We do understand that for some young people this would not be an appropriate way for them to learn this particular life skill due to their additional support needs. • If it is essential to drop off an item please wait outside the main entrance and telephone the school so someone can come and help you from the office. Please note that first thing in the morning is a busy time with calls.
