The Alternative Certification Model

Completion of National Qualification Courses

As you know we are in the process of collecting demonstrated attainment for each senior phase pupil. Most key pieces of evidence will be collected by 27 May but, that said, we do have some assessments running after that date.

Where young people have completed all assessments prior to 27 May they may be advised that they do not need to attend school, but they must remain available as we may be in touch as we check through each candidate's assessment evidence. This applies to all Senior Phase Pupils (S4 – S6).

School Leaving Date

The statutory school leaving date is 31 May each year. As indicated above, if a young person has completed all of their assessments before 31 May they do not need to attend school if they are leaving.

Sharing of provisional results

Following moderation of each candidate's demonstrated attainment (key pieces of assessment and supplementary evidence), we will issue a letter to each senior phase pupil detailing their provisional results. This will be issued in mid-June.

SQA Results

The SQA will issue final results on 10 August. This is when candidates will receive their SQA certificate.

Start of new courses for 2021-2022 - change of timetable

The week beginning 31 May 2021 will be a virtual induction week for current S4 and S5 pupils who are returning to school and information on this will come nearer the time.

The new timetable will start on Monday 7 June. We look forward to starting new courses with our young people at this point.

S1 Reports

Interim Reports will contain information about the Curriculum for Excellence levels as well as effort, behaviour and homework. We have asked teachers to focus on these regarding this term so this should give a good indication of how young people have settled into school since our return after the Easter holidays. These will be completed by teachers ready for issue in early June.

S2 Reports

Young people currently in S2 will receive a "settling in" report written by their new S3 teachers following the change of timetable as detailed above. Therefore, it will reflect their effort, behaviour and homework in their new courses. Where possible it will also contain a Curriculum for Excellence Level. This will be issued by the end of term.
