These days there are many different pathways a young person can follow from school into work. Sometimes the sheer variety of different options can seem a bit confusing.



Helping young people and their parents, employers and staff in schools and other places of learning to understand the many different pathways available is essential if we are to meet the needs and aspirations of all.



I am confident that this booklet of progression maps will form an invaluable guide for young people - and those who are returning to study later in life - to understand how they can make the best of their potential.


